Professional Experience

Mr. John Byers is on the faculty at City University of Seattle as an Associate Professor. Mr. Byers began his law enforcement career as a Patrol Officer and Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) with the Bristol Tennessee Police Department in 1996. In 1998, he cross-trained as a Public Safety Officer (Police Officer, Fire Fighter and EMT). In 1999, Mr. Byers was selected for the Criminal Investigations Division where he investigated drug, gambling and vice crimes, while supplementing the regional drug task force as an undercover agent.

From 2002 to 2006, Mr. Byers was a Special Agent for the Air Force Office of Special Investigations (AFOSI), holding assignments at Patrick Air Force Base, FL and San Antonio, TX. During his time with AFOSI, he gained experience with anti-terrorism measures, vulnerability assessments, criminal investigations, counterintelligence matters, and major fraud investigations. In 2006, he made a brief stop as a Special Agent for the NASA Office of Inspector General Office of Investigations before being offered a Special Agent position with the Defense Criminal Investigative Service (DCIS), which is the criminal investigative arm of the Department of Defense's Office of Inspector General. He began his DCIS career in the New Orleans Resident Agency before transferring to the Huntsville (Alabama) Post of Duty. In 2014, Special Agent Byers deployed to the DCIS Afghanistan Resident Agency in Kabul, Afghanistan. Special Agent Byers has been a part-time Computer Crimes Agent since 2009 and was selected for a full-time Cyber Crimes position with the

DCIS Cyber Field Office, Eastern Resident Agency upon his return from Afghanistan in 2014.

Mr. Byers is a certified Digital Media Collector and Digital Forensic Examiner for the Department of Defense, and a recipient of the DCIS Million Dollar Club award. Mr. Byers also received the Secretary of Defense Medal for the Global War on Terrorism and the Department of Defense Office of Inspector General Eagle Award for his service in Afghanistan. He holds a Master of Policy Management in Public Policy from Georgetown University and a B.A. in History and Political Science from King University. Mr. Byers also serves as an intelligence officer in the U.S. Navy Reserve.
